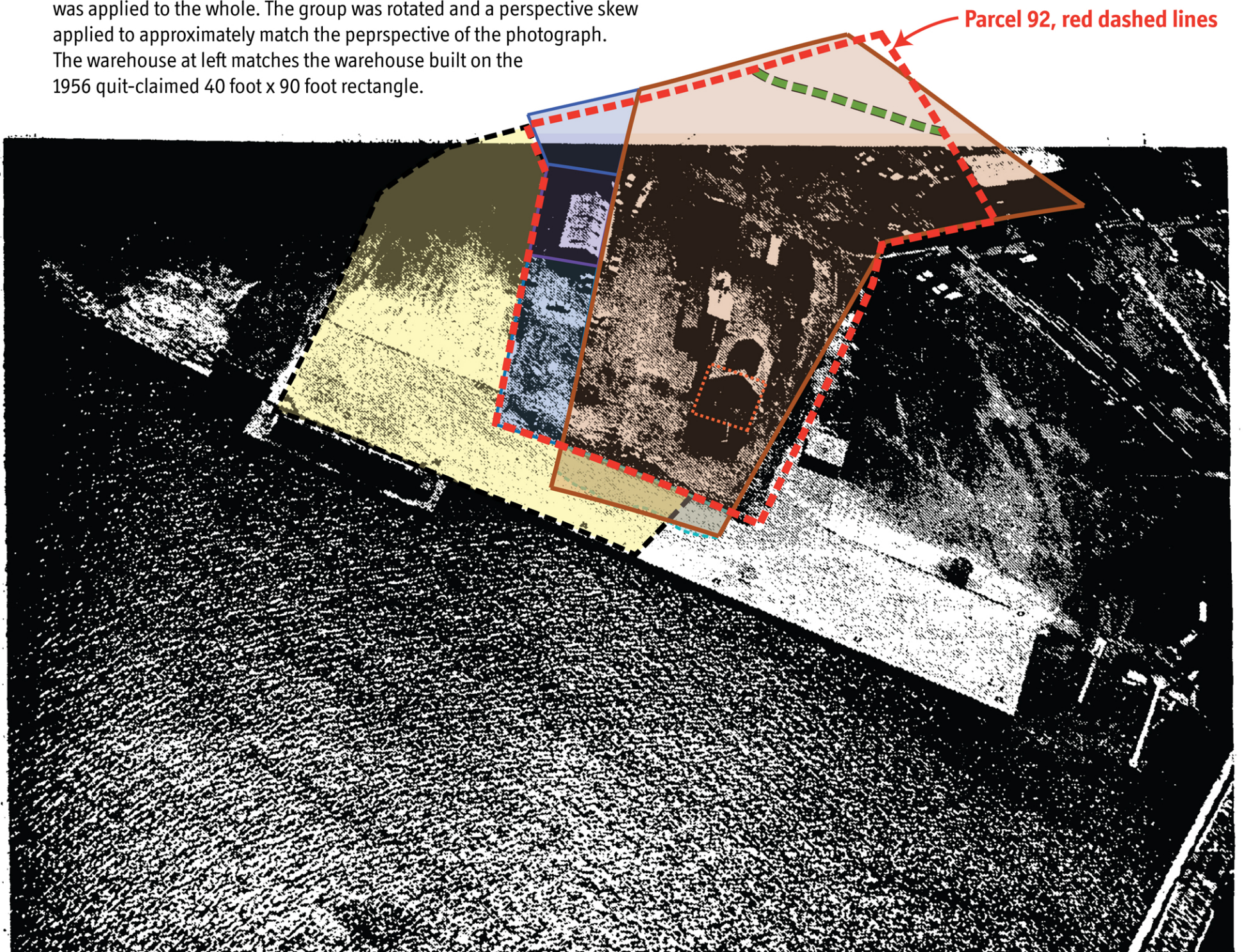


This photograph is from the July 1st 1965, Door County Advocate. It shows that the filled New City Dock bulkhead encased -- filled around -- the Parcel 92 Door County Co-op Dock, including its 1956 and 1964 side dock extensions. Note the warehouse at the left (south) side of the dock, and the Granary closest to the water.

STURGEON BAY'S modern new city dock will be dedicated with appropriate fanfare sometime in August. The dock is expected to strengthen the city's position for sharing in Great Lakes shipping trade. The dock is at the west end of the highway bridge. —Harmann.

The parcel legal description polygons, together with the Granary footprint, were grouped together so that the perspective adjustment was applied to the whole. The group was rotated and a perspective skew applied to approximately match the perspective of the photograph. The warehouse at left matches the warehouse built on the 1956 quit-claimed 40 foot x 90 foot rectangle.
